



Instructor Candidate Requirements

All applicants must meet all of the following criteria to be considered:

- Be associated with a Safe Kids coalition
- Carry current, national child passenger safety (CPS) certification

National Requirements

- Read Instructor Candidate information at <http://www.safekids.org/certification/instructor.html>.
- Register on-line through your online profile (need user name and password) and click on “Register for Instructor Candidacy”. Have a credit card available in order to pay the \$75 fee.
- Once registered, you will receive an email confirmation from Safe Kids Worldwide with instructions for completing the required documentation for candidacy. Paperwork must be received by Safe Kids Worldwide at least six weeks prior to teaching a course.
- Review the Instructor Candidate evaluation; these are skills in which you will need to exhibit to be a successful candidate.

Nebraska requirements

- **Be approved as a Child Passenger Safety Senior Checker, see guidelines.** Annually submit an application and be approved as a Senior Checker. Sr. Checker status may change based on participation level and instructor and/or CPS Board recommendation.
- Complete the Nebraska “Child Passenger Instructor Application” which includes answering three questions, reading the roles and responsibilities and obtaining a letter of

support from your organization. Questionnaire and letter of support along with national paperwork needs to be sent to Safe Kids Nebraska, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, NE, 68509. Attention: Jeanne Bietz.

- Complete “Record Checks” authorization and submit to Tim Jasnoch.
- Act in the role of a “Course Assistant” for one whole class. See “Course Assistant” guidelines.
